#### PROPERTY TAX REBATE PROGRAM

Mayor Rahm Emanuel and the City Council worked to establish this program to provide property tax relief for qualifying homeowners citywide. It is accepting applications at 26 locations in Chicago but the deadline to apply for the rebate is Wednesday, Nov. 30th. The Rebate Program includes a standard rebate for qualifying homeowners, a senior

Jubilee of Mercy

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ:

As the Jubilee of Mercy concludes, I invite you to reflect on opportunities to continue accompanying the poor in our midst, including through the Catholic Campaign for Human Development (CCHD). For over forty-five years, CCHD has been a living example of our Church's social teaching, offering a 'hand-up' to empower the poor to help themselves improve their lives and the livelihood of their families and others. This year, CCHD is funding twenty-eight organizations that are addressing the roots causes of poverty with seniors, youth, immigrants, people with disabilities and workers in Cook and Lake Counties.

This year a collaborative effort by several CCHD grantees helped pass the Illinois Domestic Workers' Bill of Rights (HB 1288). This law grants domestic workers – caretakers, housekeepers, those who clean and do household maintenance – the same legal protections as other workers. This victory directly lifts up the poor.

Please make a special effort during this Thanksgiving season to give generously to the CCHD Collection the weekend of November 19-20. Your contribution will enable the poor to achieve greater dignity and all of us to work together to build God's kingdom of justice.

#### "JESUS, THE KING"

Several centuries ago, a King was the powerful leader of an area, a government or a nation. In some countries the King still has a lot of power and governance is handed down from the King to the oldest child. In some places today, the King is more of a "figurehead" with limited power and functions.

Our relationship with Jesus as or king is much stronger and deeper than that of a political ruler. St. Paul says in the Second Reading, "all things were created through Him and for Him". Because we were created, we have a special relationship. When you create something you have a special belonging to the one who created. Your existence and form were in His hands from the beginning. The sculptured piece of art has a relationship to the artist but even more, the very matter of existence is owed to the artist. So it is with us and Jesus. Jesus also reconciled us and all things, to God through shedding His blood on the cross. Jesus, as a King, always is caring, faithful and loving. He has poured out His very self for us.

What response do we make to Him? We keep His "Great Commandment "of Love. We try to live lives of faithfulness. We have opened ourselves to the action of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit in our lives, through the grace of Baptism. We respond with prayer, adoration and rejoicing.

One thief on the Cross looked at the situation he was in. He too was sharing a cross and the jeers of the crowd. He saw how Jesus suffered though He was completely innocent. He saw 'King' written on the cross and heard the people mockingly call Him king. He prayed, "Lord, remember me when you
