From the Desk of Fr. Francis

Greetings of Christ's Peace and Joy! Hope you all had a blessed week.

Thanks

Thanks to all who helped with the Lunar New Year celebration and the Super Duper Bowl event last Sunday. We are especially grateful to **Sharon Wong** for taking lead for the New Year celebration, and to **George Lee** for the Super Bowl Event. Both events went very well. It was a busy but enjoyable day!



Today's Gospel offers us a lot of lessons to reflect and to practice. In his interpretation, Fr. Eugene Hensell shares the following insights.

- 1) Your righteousness. The main principle guiding the entire Sermon on the Mount (Mt 5-7) is enunciated in the disclaimer of Jesus that he has not come to abolish the law or the prophets, but to fulfill them. The goal in all this is, "Unless your righteousness surpasses that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will not enter the kingdom of heaven." What follows are examples of how he understands fulfilling the law and the prophets.
- 2) Five topics are presented: law, anger, adultery, divorce, and oaths. Neither Jesus nor the Church after him approached these topics from a purely legalistic perspective. In fact, much of the emphasis here is showing that one must go beyond the literal understanding of the prescription and discover a deeper meaning below the surface. There is an important internal challenge contained in all of these topics.
- 3) Challenges. Throughout the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus will show that the way one fulfills the law and the prophets is through love of God, neighbor, and self. Mindless legalism fails here. Anger can be understood as a form of killing. While it might not cause immediate physical death, uncontrolled anger does much harm and can result in death, both physical and psychological. Most would not consider lust the same as committing adultery. Jesus sees the deeper reality and connects the mutual dynamics at work between lust and adultery. For Jesus, marriage is a sacred covenant that, except for certain cases of sexual misconduct, must not be broken. For people who are honest there is no need to take oaths. Nothing can guarantee an oath because it presupposes bad will or a fundamental dishonesty. All of these challenges are just examples of the higher righteousness demanded by Jesus.

'Blessed Are They Who Follow the Law of the Lord'

Some of our missionary Sisters find it difficult to go shopping when they return from poor mission countries. Having a large section with many cereal choices or many kinds of bread to choose from seems overwhelming. The abundance of food here in stores requires making choices. We are a people who face many options. We have a variety of cars, clothes, transportation, food, plants and opportunities to pick from. Even young children choose what color or what items of clothing they want to wear.

Making choices can be one of the difficult parts of life. What do I want to do with my life? Do I want to be a priest, sister, get married or live a single life? Whom do I want for a friend, a husband or wife? Where do I want to live? Today's first reading tells us, "If you chose you can keep the commandments, they will save you." Deliberately making a choice to obey the commandments will lead us to God. Sometimes we want to pick and choose. I will not steal or kill but telling lies, that is alright. I go to Church every Sunday but I am not kind to others especially within my family. The commandments help us make good moral choices. The law of love which Jesus teaches us strengthens our moral life.

March First we begin Lent. Perhaps improving how we follow the laws and teaching about our moral life which Jesus has given us, might be something to consider as we try to draw closer to God and prepare for Easter. Trying to keep the laws helps us. We do not turn completely away from God when we work at obeying the commandments and precepts of the Church. Truly, our good choices in following the law will save us.
