"OUR ADVOCATF"

One day when I was teaching, I heard myself say to the children the same thing, in the same words that my mother said in a statement to me. At first I was surprised. Other times we find ourselves hearing as it were the voice of our parents inside of us reminding us not to do something or telling us how we "should" do something. Parents are often the most formative people in our lives.

In today's gospel, Jesus tells us that if we keep the commandments He has given us, He will ask The Father and "the Father will send another Advocate to be with you always, the Spirit of Truth....."

An advocate is one who stays with a person to defend, and explain, especially in a court situation. The Holy Spirit, whom Jesus tells us about, will be our defense against evil. The Spirit is the one who teaches us, leads us, and helps us in our decision making process. The Advocate, the Holy Spirit, is in us and fills us with the gifts which enable us to live according to the commandments. The Holy Spirit is that "small", still voice that urges us to be closer to God, to imitate and act like Jesus. It is the Spirit who helps us and calls us to be open to the action of grace, God's gift, in us. Through our obedience to the commandments and responsiveness to the Spirit, Jesus will be able to reveal Himself to us. Jesus wants to reveal Himself to us. We need to be open through the help of the Advocate, the Holy Spirit to Jesus' self-revelation..
