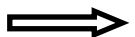


Living As Missionary Disciples

Statement of Cardinal Cupich on the Rescission of DACA - September 5, 2017

Today President Trump ended the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) program and the dreams of nearly a million young people covered by the executive order and applying for inclusion. In the past the president stated that the Dreamer story “is about the heart,” yet today’s decision is nothing short of heartless. The Dreamers are now left in a 6 month limbo, during which Congress is supposed to pass comprehensive immigration reform, a feat they have been unable to achieve for a decade. In fact, this inability to agree on a just immigration system led President Obama to sign the executive order protecting minor children brought to this country by their parents.

As the considerations of the “heart” seemed to be insufficient to keep protection in place, Congress must now act decisively and swiftly. An immediate first step is for our leaders to pass legislation that will protect those previously covered by the DACA program, while they deal with the long-overdue comprehensive reform of our immigration system. They must be guided by compassion and respect for human dignity, and honestly consider the substantial evidence that deporting these young Americans would do great economic harm to the states where they reside.

With the bishops in this country, we remain committed to upholding the dignity of all persons and the fundamental right of all to live free from fear in the nation founded on that promise.

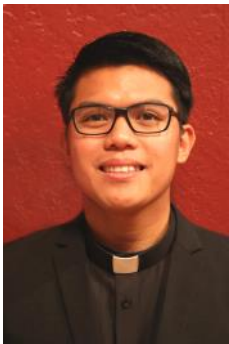

"SAY YOU'RE SORRY!" ~Sister Caritas

In most families there is a ritual of sorts that parents use to teach their children forgiveness of one another. My parents would bring my brother and I together and tell us, "Say you are sorry." This usually happened when we had a "fight" or disagreement with each other. We had to say we were sorry. Maybe even hug each other. Sometimes, at the time, one or other of us did not feel sorry but we did it anyway because there was no way out of it. Later we did not even remember what the "fight" was all about.

Perhaps the most profound and most difficult challenge of living the Catholic Christian life is to be a person who forgives. We have the example of the story in today's Gospel. We also have the example of Jesus. When He was nailed to the cross and in the process of dying, He said, "Father, forgive them they know not what they do." He forgave Peter for denying that he knew Jesus. Jesus forgave sinners in the process of working some of His miracles.

When people come to us and ask our forgiveness and say they are sorry, it can be easier to forgive. The more difficult situations are the times when people do not ask to be forgiven. Perhaps they do not know the words to say. Maybe they do not know they have done something to us that has hurt us or was gravely wrong. As Jesus said, "They know not what they do." Sometimes we want to carry the anger, the hurt, and the grudge with us and will not let it go. We are unfree until we forgive "from the heart." Sometimes it may seem impossible to forgive. Then we have to try to turn to God presenting our situation and begging for the grace of forgiveness. God will always give us the grace. Sometimes it will take some effort and time. We can forgive and God is with us gracing us with the ability to do so. God walks with us as we make the on-going effort. God always forgives us if we ask. We need to forgive others including forgiving ourselves.
