Greetings of Christ's Peace and Joy! Hope you all had a blessed week.

Parish Financial and Ministerial Report for the Fiscal Year ending 6/30/2017

First of all, I would like to thank all of our Finance Council members: Nick Andriacchi, George Lee, Lily May, Paul Lau, and Wendy Sin, for their expertise and commitment. We meet monthly to review and plan for our parish financial matters. Our accountant from the Archdiocese comes by-weekly to keep our books clean and orderly. We do our best to follow the best practices of the Archdiocese in terms of accountability and transparency.

Included in this bulletin are some highlights of the parish financial and ministerial report for the fiscal year ending 6/30/2017.

Highlights of 12-Month financial result:

- \$19,332 Net Ordinary Deficit for this period, due to higher staffing and administrative cost.
- Collection of \$30,486 for works of charity.
- Completion of the Accessibility Project with Elevator fully installed and operational.
- To Teach Who Christ Is campaign was successful.

Highlights of this period's ministerial work:

- We welcomed 14 new families into our parish and had 13 children and 6 adults baptized during this period.
- Increasing emphasis was placed on Evangelization work:
 - RCIA program welcomed 10 candidates to learn Catholic faith.
 - Outreach and Community Service programs provided volunteer service at St. James Food Pantry, Sister House and Warren Barr Senior Home.
 - Caring for the sick was emphasized e.g. Anointing of the Sick was celebrated at Mass on October 23, 2016.
- Educational and Spiritual formation programs were offered:
 - Formation sessions for parents
 - Catholicism 101 Sessions
 - Parish Pilgrimage to La Salette Shrines, Twin Lakes, Wisconsin on October 22, 2016.
 - Special presentation and discussion of Landato Si ("On Care for our Common Home" written by Pope Francis) examining our stewardship and discipleship by Sr. Dawn Nothwehr on October 30, 2016.
 - Liturgical Ministers Gathering & Renewal led by Fr. Richard Fragomeni on Nov. 5, 2016.
 - Advent Retreat, a day of reflection and sharing, led by Fr. Ed Shea, on Dec. 17, 2016.
 - Lenten Retreat on March 26, 2017
 - Lenten Cantonese Recollection Days on April 1-2, 2017

Your financial sacrifice and support helped our parish become financially more viable. Your dedication and commitment enabled our parish to continue its work in evangelization. I truly appreciate all you do for our parish.

Looking forward, we will continue to intentionally work on Evangelization and Missionary Disciples. With your active participation, together, we can make our parish a truly welcoming and nourishing community of faith.

This weekend we celebrate the seminarians of the Archdiocese of Chicago through our second collection. By offering our financial support we provide these young men with the critical education and training they need to shepherd our parishes and administer the sacraments. 

"SEEK THE LORD" ~Sister Caritas

One of the very common games which children play is called, "Hide and Seek." One child is it. They hide their eyes and count and everyone else hides. The person counting then stops counting and finds all the children hiding. One of the hiding students, the first one found, becomes the next student who counts and seeks the rest. It is fun.

The first reading today encourages us to Seek the Lord while He may be found. Call upon Him while He is near. "To seek the Lord" entails having an open heart. It means we are a person who wants to find the Lord, God. We want to be close to God. We want to be as close to God as we possibly can. This closeness to God is what God wants for us, more than anything. One way we can be close to God is through prayer. We can be looking in all the usual places for God. We can look in Church. God is present in the tabernacle, waiting for us to visit. We can look for God in Mass and Holy Communion. This is one very compete way we can find God and be one with God. We can look for God in the Word of God, Holy Scripture. He speaks to us in the Word Of God. We can find God in each other, in the kindness and care we show each other. We can find God in the beauty of His creation. We can find God in the beauty of the sun, sky, water, flowers and the smile of our friends and little children. God is everywhere. We have only to do the work of seeking Him. He will always welcome us. He seeks us too. It's really up to you to SEEK the Lord with all your Heart!


