Wisdom on Family

As we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family this weekend, the Church invites us to reflect on and pray for our own families. Pope Francis in *The Joy of Love* offered insightful wisdom on family for us all to ponder and practice. I am going to offer a few excerpts here for your contemplation.

*The Bible is full of families, births, love stories and family crises. This is true from its very first page, with the appearance of Adam and Eve's family with all its burden of violence but also its enduring strength (cf. Gn 4) to its very last page, where we behold the wedding feast of the Bride and the Lamb (Rev 21: 2, 9.).

*The triune God is a communion of love, and the family is its living reflection. St. John Paul shed light on this when he said, "Our God in his deepest mystery is not solitude, but a family, for he has within himself fatherhood, sonship and the essence of the family, which is love. That love, in the divine family, is the Holy Spirit."

- *Labor also makes possible the development of society and provides for the sustenance, stability and fruitfulness of one's family: "May you see the prosperity of Jerusalem all the days of your life! May you see your children's children!" (Ps 128:5-6).
- *The Church is a family of families, constantly enriched by the lives of all those domestic churches.
- *It is important for Christians to show their love by the way they treat family members who are less knowledgeable about the faith, weak or less sure in their convictions.
- *In family life, we need to cultivate that strength of love which can help us fight every evil threatening it.
- *Marriage is a precious sign, for "which a man and a woman celebrate the sacrament of marriage, God is, as it were, 'mirrored' in them; he impresses in them his own features and the indelible character of his love. Marriage is the icon of God's love for us.
- *The family is thus an agent of pastoral activity through its explicit proclamation of the Gospel and its legacy of carried forms of witness, namely solidarity with the poor, openness to a diversity of people, the protection of creation, moral and material solidarity with other families, including those most in need, commitment to the promotion of the common good and the transformation of unjust social structures, beginning in the territory in which the family lives, through the practices of the corporal and spiritual works of mercy.

May the Holy Family inspire your family to be holy and joyful. May the Lord bless your family with abundant peace and love.

"Be a HOLY FAMILY" ~Sister Caritas

Our world today is filled with many events which act contrary to our understanding of what it means to be a Holy Family. We see and hear values which are contrary to the Catholic Christian teachings, being held up in public. We could today ask the question Pilate asked Jesus, "What is truth?" as we hear and read things we have held to build our nation, being ignored, challenged and rejected. Honesty is not upheld. We hear of abuse being condoned, disrespectful language is frequently spoken even in front of women and children. It is spoken sometimes by women and children.

Things were not so moral in the time of Jesus. Herold killed infant boy children to kill the "young potential king" since he wanted to be king... Pharisees and Scribes taught one thing and often lived another. The poor, lame, and blind were never given a chance to move up in culture or be healed and helped.

What made Mary, Joseph and Jesus Holy? Besides being chosen by God, Jesus being the Son of God, they built their lives on love for each other, fulfillment of and knowledge of the law, and belief in each other and in the messages of the angels sent to them. They followed the will of God.

How do we build a Holy family and maintain this life in these times? The same values (we are chosen by God, too) as Mary, Joseph, and Jesus practiced. Most of all as I think about where we receive the strength to live a holy life, I think two special things are important. Believe in God and God's action, sending "angels in your life", believe what the Church teaches, and most of all, center yourself and your family on prayer and The Holy Eucharist. We cannot stay alive without food each day. We cannot stay alive and be holy without the Faith and the Holy Eucharist. Eucharist is the mystery of faith. It is the nourishment of our faith and of a holy life. The world needs holy families. We are called to be these HOLY Families today!


