Renew My Church

As Samuel was called by the Lord in today's first reading, the Lord is calling our Archdiocese to *Renew My Church*. It is a process to evaluate our mission and structures and to find the best possible ways to carry out the mission of Jesus Christ in this local Church. The mission driven objectives of *Renew My Church* are three:

- 1. **Making disciples**: Inviting all people to have a true encounter and relationship with Jesus Christ. Much intentional evangelization will be emphasized.
- 2. **Building communities**: Creating and supporting vibrant parishes and schools to build strong bonds among each other and promote active participation in the life of the Church.
- 3. **Inspiring witnesses**: Empowering all Christians to come together in solidary to spread the Good News and transform the world.

St. Therese Parish and School is assigned to a grouping with 7 other parishes and schools in our neighborhood. Beginning on Saturday Feb. 3rd, we will begin to meet and to discuss the realities and needs of our neighborhood. Parishioners at large will have two chances to hear about the process and some new possibilities in the next few weeks. By the end of May, the grouping members will offer a suggestion to the Cardinal and then it is up to the Cardinal to make the final decision.

As our parish and school go through this process, I will keep you updated as often as possible and I ask you to keep our church and our grouping in your prayers.

In rural Peru, like in many other countries, opportunities for the faithful to celebrate even the basic rituals of our Catholic faith are often few and far between. Frequently, children cannot receive the sacraments of initiation, and Mass cannot be held regularly. Without missionaries and catechists, the people living there cannot learn about, experience and share the beauty of our Catholic way of life.

Your support to the Collection for the Church in Latin America has helped the Siervas del Plan de Dios (Servants of the Plan of God) train lay people to become Catholic missionaries and catechists in parishes. The sisters have set up a missionary formation program as a step toward enlivening and sustaining the Catholic faith.

The sisters are trained professionals providing comprehensive services to their communities. Sr. Carmen

Cárdenas, general coordinator of the Servants, said that the education her sisters receive to become nurses, doctors, teachers, administrators, and psychologists helps provide the best services to the frailest and the poorest in the communities they serve. The sisters teach children and work in hospitals as doctors and nurses, caring for the sick and terminally ill, as well as caring for those who are living on the streets. Sometimes they are the only health practitioners in the area.

With your help, the sisters bring the love and tenderness of God to these remote areas and have shown people living in Peru the mercy of Christ.

"Speak, Listen, Follow" ~Sister Caritas

In our scripture readings today we hear important people in our faith story speaking. We hear Samuel being called by God. Samuel does not recognize it at first. Eli helps Samuel recognize the call of God. Samuel says, "Speak Lord for your servant is listening." Samuel follows God and becomes a prophet.

In the Gospel John the Baptist speaks calling Jesus, "the Lamb of God." John's two disciples follow Jesus. Jesus asks them, "What are you looking for?" They are seemingly caught by surprise and say, "Where are you staying?" Jesus says, "Come and see." He invites them to be with Him. Samuel and the disciples both are given invitations. Both follow. Eli's words help Samuel. John's words help the two disciples.

We see the effect of the words of call upon these people. "The Lord was with him (Samuel), not permitting any word of his to be without effect." Many stories tell of the power of Samuel among the Jewish people. His words and actions were filled with power. In calling Samuel, God was faithful to Samuel. Samuel was faithful, with the grace of God, to God.

The disciples follow Jesus and Jesus recognizes they are looking for something. He invites them to "Come and see." With these words Jesus invites them into the mystery of call, of following, of being a disciple. What effect do Jesus' words have on Andrew? Andrew goes and brings his brother to Jesus. Andrew tells Simon, "We have found the Messiah." Peter comes and he follows.

What calls come to you in your life from God? What power do your words have? Make no mistake; what you say does affect others even if you do not know it. Your words have power to build up, tear down, or invite to new life. Think about it.




