I tried a few Protestant Churches, but the services I attended made me feel bad about life and shameful and I felt hopelessness and no Direction. Father Hardy in St. Patrick's always gave services that made u smile and

appreciate life's moments and gave hope instead on condemnation with acceptance. The catholic way of approval and approaches focus on positivity's because my life was always alone. I did all catholic rituals and was hoping god would see and something magical would happen. At this point i got a new job and moved to nice warm house and had a future in my hands. I was visiting other catholic churches and learning the disciple's creed enjoyed the mysticism of the Catholic Faith. When you do the rituals in Catholic Church you know that there is tradition and validation. I then was brought into knowledge that i had to get baptized confirmed. I then went to my hometown Chinatown where i knew the area and community and asked to be a member there. The Holy Spirit while during baptism was with me and i felt it. Life has changed so much the perfect faith that works and stays.

FATHER WALTER E. JOHNSON, M.M. 1925 - 2018



Father Walter E. Johnson, M.M. died on April 14, 2018 at Mission St. Teresa's. He was 92 years old and a Maryknoll priest for 64 years.

Walter Emmett Johnson was born on December

19, 1925 in Berwyn, Illinois, only son of Walter S. and Emily Sopcak Johnson. He attended St. Odilo Parochial School in Berwyn and graduated from Quigley Preparatory Seminary in Chicago. He entered First Philosophy class at Maryknoll Seminary, New York, on September 4, 1946. He obtained his Bachelor of Arts degree in Philosophy in 1948 and was ordained a priest at Maryknoll Seminary on June 13, 1953.

After his ordination Father Johnson was assigned to Maryknoll's Mission in the Diocese of Honolulu. He served for three years as an Assistant Pastor in Sacred Heart Parish, Punaho, Oahu. While home on vacation in 1956, he was appointed Assistant Pastor of St. Therese's Chinese Mission in Chicago. On January 4, 1963 he was assigned to the Maryknoll Mission Region in Bolivia, South America.

"THE GOOD SHEPHERD, JESUS " ~Sister Caritas

Sheep are not known to be the most intelligent animals. They easily follow the lead sheep anywhere, even over a cliff to death. That is why a shepherd is important. Once, when I went to Lincoln Park Zoo in the farm section, a couple of men were doing a sheep shearing demonstration. They would take the sheep, secure them and with a trimmer, cut off their wool. Today's reading of the Gospel talks about Jesus saying He is the Good Shepherd. He lays down His life for His sheep. We have just gone through the season of Lent and the celebration of Easter. His compassionate heart always loves us. He loves us so much He died on the cross for us and rose again, never to die again. What return can we make to such a wonderful shepherd? How can we thank Him? Following His commandment of love is how we can show our thanks. He calls us to be shepherds for others. He calls us to reach out and show care to others. Then we too will be Good Shepherds.


