

The Holy Eucharist



We had a lot of joyful and fruitful celebrations in May: First Communion, May Crowning, Mother's Day, Fr. Christian's First Mass of Thanksgiving. Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, the source and summit of our life and of the life of our Church.

We all know the importance of the Holy Eucharist and its indispensability for our growth. Recently I came across a wonderful insight on how the Mass can help us experience purification, illumination, and union.

Eucharist as a way of purification is particularly experienced through the Penitential Rite, which prepares the celebrant as well as all participants to receive God's mercy and forgiveness, to have an open heart and mind for the Word of God.

Eucharist as a way of illumination is particularly experienced through the Word of God which enlightens our hearts and minds if we are properly prepared and nourishes our hunger and thirst.

Eucharist as a way of union is particularly experienced through the reception of the Body and Blood of Christ. Christ becomes part of us in the Eucharist. We also use the name Communion to describe the mystery of our union with Christ.

This feast invites us to deepen our love for the Eucharist.

"Mystery of Faith" by Sister Caritas

One of the best smells is the smell of homemade bread just out of the oven. When you enter the house you know your Mother was making bread. My Mom would make homemade bread. On the night of the Passover, Jesus took bread, blessed it and gave it to His disciples and Apostles and said, "Take this and eat it, for this is my body." He then took a cup of wine and said, "Take this and drink of this because this is my Blood of the new covenant. Whenever you do this, do this in memory of me." In this special mystery, Jesus gives us Himself completely. In John's Gospel, Jesus tells His disciples that they should eat His body and blood. Some leave Him because they do not understand. They say, "This is a hard saying." Jesus asked His Apostles if they would also leave Him. Peter answers for the group, "To who should we go, you have the words of everlasting life." Peter and the Apostles believed.

When we received Holy Communion, we believe that we are receiving the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ. We believe that the priest, though His ordination, is given the power to transform the ordinary host into the Body and Blood of Jesus. The bread does not look different nor taste different. We believe because Jesus told us, "This is my body. This is My Blood." It is truly, "The Mystery of Faith." Only faith helps us to be able to believe we receive Jesus... Like Thomas we say, "My Lord and MY God". 'I do believe. Help my unbelief." This is the way Jesus nourishes us and is present with us always. What great love! Jesus gives Himself completely to us in this "Mystery of Faith".


