**Greetings of Christ's Peace and Joy! Hope you all had a blessed week.**

### **Thanks and Congratulations**

Thanks to all young people who attended our last Youth Event on Sat. Oct. 6<sup>th</sup>. It was wonderful to see so many young people who came out. Thanks to **Nick Andriacchi** and all adults who led and helped with the event.

Congratulations to **George Lee**, recipient of this year's *Christifideles* Award. Bishop Ron Hicks, on behalf of the Cardinal who is in Rome for the 2018 Synod, distributed the award to parishioners from all over the Archdiocese last Sunday at Holy Name Cathedral. It was wonderful and inspirational to witness so many people who were thanked for their extraordinary services to this local church.

This award is given to individuals who are "to be practicing Catholics who manifest an understanding of the teachings of the Church and have been graced with a life formed in the Catholic Spiritual Tradition. They have used their talents to deepen the life of the Church in the parish and have served in an extraordinary way the ministry of the parish."

George has been a longtime parishioner and has been involved in many parish committees and ministries. We thank him for his dedication and we are confident that he will continue to serve our community well.

### **Archbishop Oscar Romero and Pope Paul VI**

As the 2018 Synod of Bishops continues in Rome to reflect on the topics of young people, faith and vocational discernment, this Sunday the Holy Father will canonize Archbishop Oscar Romero and Pope Paul VI into sainthood.

According to Catholic News Service, Archbishop Romero was "the archbishop of the nation's capital city of San Salvador. He was shot while celebrating Mass March 24, 1980, during the birth of a civil war between leftist guerrilla forces and the dictatorial government of the right.

An outspoken critic of the violence and injustices being committed at the time, Romero was declared a martyr who was killed in hatred of the faith for his vocal defense of human rights."

Pope Paul VI was "born Giovanni Montini in 1897 in the town of Concesio, Italy, the future Pope Paul VI was ordained a priest at the age of 22. He served as Archbishop of Milan prior to his election as Bishop of Rome in 1963.

As pope, he oversaw much of the Second Vatican Council, which had been opened by Pope St. John XXIII, and in 1969 promulgated a new Roman Missal. He died in 1978, and was beatified by Pope Francis Oct. 19, 2014.

Pope Francis himself unofficially confirmed the news of Paul VI's canonization during his annual meeting with the priests of Rome Feb. 17.

Apart from his role in the council, Paul VI is most widely know for his landmark encyclical *Humanae Vitae*, which was published in 1968 and reaffirmed the Church's teaching against contraception in wake of the sexual revolution. This year marks the 50th anniversary the historic encyclical."

### ***"Nothing is Impossible" by Sister Caritas***

There are many saturations in our everyday life, in which we feel there is not a way to accomplish our goal. We look at our talents and resources and we often feel blocked and defeated. We look for another way, another skill, and another person who can help solve our problem. We either keep trying or searching or we give up.

Our Gospel today has a young man coming to Jesus proclaiming that he has kept the commandments and lived according to the Jewish teachings. Jesus tells him, he is "not far from the kingdom," but lacks one thing. The young man has put his trust in what he has, whom he is, and his reputation. His trust in things and that makes him unable to follow Jesus.

In some or many ways we may be like this young man. To give up our security, which we place in what we have is difficult. What material things will you detach yourself from to draw closer to God, to enter the kingdom of heaven? What talent or ability do you take pride in and as it were, say to God, "I will give you everything but not that ...skill, ability, talent accomplishment." Maybe it is a relationship that keeps you from drawing closer to God. We trust in that person but not as much in God.

Salvation, reaching the kingdom of God, being fully united with God, are all graces, gifts of God. In reality, we cannot earn the kingdom of God through our virtuous actions, or other gifts or actions. We are called to prepare ourselves to be open and to embrace the graces God so willing showers upon us. We are called to do "our part." The disciples cannot understand the saying about the camel and the eye of a needle. To them it seems impossible. Jesus tells them "Nothing is impossible for God." So it is in our lives. To reach the Kingdom of God we must do what seems completely impossible at times. We are called to the journey of total trust in God. We are called to give our whole selves to Him and to place nothing in "first place before God." Our journey and the promise of the kingdom, heaven, began with Baptism. Where are you in your journey? What seems like "camels" in your lives? "Nothing is impossible with God." Absolutely nothing!
