Renew My Church Update

Cardinal Cupich and the Archdiocese's Presbyteral Council met and, based on the Archdiocesan Commission's recommendation and other considerations, the Cardinal made several decisions regarding the grouping's structure. These decisions were shared with parishioners and school families during the Wednesday, Nov. 28th Renew My Church community meeting.

All Saints-St. Anthony Parish, St. Barbara Parish and School, St. Mary of Perpetual Help Parish and St. Therese Chinese Parish and School

St. Therese Chinese School will assume responsibility of St. Barbara School, retaining campuses at both the existing St. Therese Chinese school building and the existing St. Barbara school building, under the St. Therese Chinese School leadership and name. The academic program will include expanded early childhood (pre-K) at the St. Barbara campus with pre-K through 8 at both sites pending enrollment. School leadership structure will consist of one principal with two administrators one at each site. The school will be led by the current St. Therese Chinese School principal. The current St. Barbara School principal will serve as an administrator at the St. Barbara campus and will remain involved in leadership decisions. Current St. Barbara School students will be automatically accepted into St. Therese Chinese School. St. Barbara School faculty and staff will be given priority status in filling positions at the expanded St. Therese Chinese School.

Cardinal Cupich has requested that further discussion and consultation take place on the future of the parishes of All Saints-St. Anthony, St. Barbara, St. Mary of Perpetual Help and St. Therese Chinese and the Archdiocesan Center for Chinese Apostolate. Therefore, a decision on these parishes will be delayed until at least mid-January 2019.

As we continue to wait for the Cardinal's decision regarding the future of our Church, I know most of us are very anxious to find out. Waiting becomes doubly hard. However, I can assure you that in all the proposed scenarios, St. Therese Church will stay open. We know the final decision belongs to the Cardinal. With good faith, I invite you to live out the Spirit of the Advent, a time of waiting and a wonderful opportunity to treasure the values of waiting and anticipating for new life to come.

Let's make this Advent a time of "renew our faith." Please keep praying for Renew My Church.

RESPECT LIFE CORNER

One Simple Thing You Can Do to Support Adoption and Foster Care by Stephanie Foley

November is a time when we pause and give thanks for the many blessings God has given us. It is also National Adoption Awareness Month, which is fitting because we should all remember to take the time to be grateful for the adoptive families, birth families, and foster families who give life and love to so many. Kathryn Jean Lopez, from <u>National Review</u>, and <u>Lisa Wheeler</u>, an adoption and foster care advocate, discussed about the urgency and need when it comes to adoption and foster care. The way we think and talk about adoption and foster care is important, and simply changing the way we talk about these issues can make a huge difference.

"One of the things that I have been trying to emphasize to people is that not every single person, obviously, is called to foster care or adoption," said Lopez. "But everybody has a role to play in this. And I'd also add, a lot more people than realize are called to this."

A misconception that people refer to those who foster or adopt children as 'saints' or 'heroes', which makes it seem as though it is out of reach for the average family. But we're all called to that. That doesn't let you off the hook because they do hard things. We're all supposed to do hard things.

Wheeler agreed, saying, "When there are those kinds of conversations happening, it makes the rest of the community attach themselves to looking at adoption as a 'last resort' or only something that the 'saints' do or not something that an average family would choose to do. And we need to get away from that." "One of my favorite quotes," Wheeler continued, "is a quote that says, 'God knew that it doesn't matter how your children get to your family, it just matters that they get there.' And I would like to see us equalizing more in our conversation the fact that children are a blessing, and whether they come to us biologically or through the supernatural gift of adoption, it's the same. And every family should discern how they can be a caretaker of the modern-day orphans of the world."

Both Wheeler and Lopez emphasized the need, in particular, for those who are Catholic and pro-life to be thinking and talking about adoption and foster care more often and in a more positive way. "It's something that every family, especially every Catholic family, should consider," Wheeler said. "Whether they have one child or 10 children, it is a calling that is not only difficult but it needs to be a part of our pro-life conversation. If we're going to be fully open to life, we need to be talking about adoption."

Lopez concurred, saying, "If you call yourself pro-life, this has got to be a priority. If you talk about abortion you should talk just as much about adoption, because this is a serious alternative that is not explored. The education isn't there and the support isn't there."
