

#### "HOLY FAMILY" by Sister Caritas

What is a family? Today, in our world there are many kinds of families. Originally we considered those related by blood as families. Today we have families with children and a single parent. We have families in which the grandparents are raising the children as the parents may be sick, dead or in jail. We have families with members of our extended families. We have families where children have two fathers or two mothers as people have gotten divorced and then married and the children move between the two sets of parents.

What are the common virtues or qualities which make a family? If we look at the "Holy Family" we know Jesus was loved, protected and cared for by both Mary and Joseph. They did all the normal things like teaching Him to talk, walk, feed himself, and pray. Jesus learned from their example. They put God first in their lives. They obeyed the laws, directives and practices of the Jewish faith. There was respect in their family. Mary respected Joseph. Joseph respected Mary. Both parents loved and respected Jesus and Jesus returned the respect and love. All the places in the Gospel where we hear about Mary and Jesus, we see the profound love and respect of Jesus for His Mother. Mary was with Jesus, at times in His ministry and was with Him all the way to the cross and burial. Though there is no recorded story of Jesus coming to Mary at Easter but He probably did. Life in the Holy Family was good but it was not easy.

What are the qualities or virtues practiced in your family? Is there respect and love? Is there care and encouragement? Do you encourage and direct your children? Is there gentleness and strength? Pray to the Holy Family to help you. Ask God for all the graces and help you need to be a good family. God will be with you and present in your family just as God was with Mary and Joseph as they raised Jesus, God's Son. God will always give yon what y our need. Love one another.
