It was a beautiful celebration of our young people's faith. We pray and hope that they will continue to grow in their relationship with Jesus.

### **Devotion to Mary**



May is a special month we particularly honor Mary through May Crowning and Marian prayers. We usually begin the month with a May Crowning led by our School children on May 1<sup>st</sup>. It's inspiring to witness our children to show their love for Mary. Following our School May Crowning, our annual SMI May Crowning takes place on the first Sunday of May and many of our Italian parishioners and friends gather to thank and crown Mary. Two years ago, we started a parishioner May Crowning. This year, our children will lead us again on May 19<sup>th</sup> to crown our Heavenly Mother, which is also the date for our First Communion. It will indeed be a very special day for our community.

We honor Mary because we know her unique role in our salvation mystery. It is through her YES to God that Jesus was incarnated into human flesh and became one of us. Her faithfulness to God has played an indispensable role for our eternal life. Throughout history, there has been countless devotional prayers to her and below I will list a few traditional ones for your use.

#### **1. The Angelus**

*V*— The Angel of the Lord declared unto Mary.

*R*— And she conceived by the Holy Spirit.

Hail Mary... *(Say The Hail Mary here.)*

*V*— Behold the handmaid of the Lord.

*R*— Be it done unto me according to thy word.

Hail Mary...

*V*— And the Word was made Flesh.

*R*— And dwelt among us.

Hail Mary...

*V*— Pray for us, O Holy Mother of God.

*R*— That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.



**LET US PRAY:** Pour forth, we beseech you, O Lord, your grace into our hearts, that we to whom the incarnation of Christ, your Son, was made known by the message of an angel, may by his passion and cross be brought to the glory of his resurrection. Through the same Christ our Lord. Amen.

## 2. Hail, Holy Queen

Hail, holy Queen, mother of mercy, our life, our sweetness and our hope. To thee do we cry, poor banished children of Eve. To thee do we send up our sighs, mourning and weeping in this valley of tears. Turn then, most gracious advocate, thine eyes of mercy toward us, and after this our exile, show unto us the blessed fruit of thy womb, Jesus. O clement, O loving, O sweet Virgin Mary! Pray for us, O holy Mother of God, that we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ. Amen.

## 3. The Magnificat

to Abraham and to his posterity forever. (Luke 1:46-55)

Remember, O most gracious Virgin Mary, that never was it known that any one who fled to thy protection, implored thy help or sought thy intercession, was left unaided. Inspired by this confidence, I fly unto thee, O Virgin of virgins my Mother; to thee do I come, before thee I stand, sinful and sorrowful; O Mother of the Word Incarnate, despise not my petitions, but in thy mercy hear and answer me, Amen.

Dear Parishioners of St. Barbara and St. Therese,

Easter Season blessings and unity greetings to you and your loved ones!

We are writing to offer you a brief update on Renew My Church. As you probably know that St. Therese and St. Barbara have had some grace-filled exchanges and encounters through our Meet & Greet, Open Houses, and joint Retreat, this week our newly formed Unification Team met for the first time. We want to ask you to join us in expressing our heartfelt appreciation to this advisory group of Parishioners for answering this call on behalf of our communities: **Hazel Alonzo, Wendy Sin, Luz Perez Kwiatkowski, Jackie Yan, Sharon Wong, Lily May, Elisa Moy, Ellen Andriacchi, Michele Worth, Ken Ricci, Lisa D. Oi, and George Lee.** Some of the significant things that these ministers will be working on are; Parish Name, Mass Schedule, Parish Council along with many other countless details that are important to the combined Parish reality between now and October. As time goes on, they will help us to get your input on some of the matters too.

At the introductory meeting, mass schedules were examined for both Parishes. Currently there are 8 Masses each weekend between the two Parishes which is a challenge for a single Pastor. In addition, there are 2 daily Masses between the two Parishes Mon-Sat. The thoughtful discussion around the table concerning each of the Masses focused on critical points including, traditions, special needs of the faith communities being addressed by that Mass, along with current numbers of the faithful attending each of the Masses.

Helpful ideas were shared that we all felt would get us to the goal of having Masses with full pews in the near future while at the same time would be manageable now in a new Parish reality. As we all experienced on Easter Sunday, a Mass where the church is full of people attending brings an energy to the liturgy which really makes Mass come alive for all of the faithful. We also acknowledged that this is a great opportunity for all members of the two communities to reflect on the importance of the Eucharist for Catholics and our responsibilities to invite more people to our worships. New Mass times at each worship site are scheduled to take effect following the unification on July 1st. A final decision on the Mass schedule will be forth coming in the next few weeks. Please keep this intention in your prayers.

We know changes are difficult and we thank you for your understanding and support as we continue to journey on our calling together as pilgrims to build the exciting new reality the grace of our Lord offers each of us through Renew My Church. ## RESPECT LIFE CORNER

**The Woman of Influence** – As May, the Month of Mary, begins, be mindful of Pope Francis' words at World Youth Day in Panama last January: “[By her yes] she became the most influential woman in history.” Not just in her time or any other time but for all time, no mortal is closer to Jesus. **Prayer for an End to Infanticide** – The U.S. Senate recently failed to pass the Born-Alive Abortion Survivors Protection Act, but that is not the end of the story. It would prohibit infanticide by ensuring that a child born alive following an attempted abortion would receive the same degree of care to preserve her or his life and health as would be given to any other child born alive at the same gestational age. Please join us in praying the Prayer for an End to Infanticide: *“Jesus, Lord of Life, transform the hearts of all elected leaders to recognize that infanticide is wrong and must not be tolerated. Open hearts and minds to recognize and defend the precious gift of every human life.”*

### **"IT IS THE LORD" by Sister Caritas**

There are times in our lives when we are in situations or places we have never been before yet they seem familiar. Sometimes someone begins talking on the phone to you and you may not be sure who they are until they say some phrase or say your name in a certain way, then you recognize them.

The Gospel story today tells of a similar situation. Peter wants to go fishing and the other disciples go. They fish all night and catch nothing. As they come closer to shore they see a man on shore and he asks if they have caught anything. They respond no and He tells them to "cast the net to the other side."

John recognizes the situation and says, "It is the Lord". Peter needing to be where Jesus was, prepares himself and jumps into the water and rushes to shore. The others come and bring the fish and Jesus invites them to breakfast.

In the reading there is an interesting statement. "None of the Apostles asked who He was because they all knew it was Jesus." Find that place outside of you that enables you to experience peace and joy and in that you can find Jesus, find God, find the Holy Spirit. Find that place deep inside of you where you recognize the "voice" of God, the words of Jesus, the call of the Holy Spirit. Take those moments which help you to recognize God, hear God call your name, know God is speaking to you, leading you. If you do that frequently you will also be able to identify situations and ways of God in your everyday life. You will be like John. "It is the Lord." You will be like the Apostles, you will not have to ask, you will know it is the Lord.

Like Peter you will be able to respond, "Yes, Lord, you know that I love you!"
