## *From the Desk of Fr. Francis*

**Greetings of Christ's Peace and Joy! Hope you all had a blessed week.**

Dear Parishioners and Friends of SS. Barbara and Therese,

Greetings of Christ's peace!

This is a historic Sunday, the first weekend for our unified parish. July 1<sup>st</sup> marked an important milestone in the life of our community. We are no longer two, but one parish. The Renew My Church journey has been hard for all of us, but it has brought us to this hopeful and graced moment. We thank God for God's continuous call and love for us all. How appropriate for us to hear from today's readings speaking about Jesus' call for his early disciples to be on their way of spreading the Good News. They were sent out to bring peace to a people who were hungry for God's peace and justice. Similarly each of us is called to be peace-makers and to be bearers of the Good News.

The celebration of the feast of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus on June 28<sup>th</sup> also reminds us of the boundless love and mercy of God through his only son Jesus Christ. It is with great confidence in God's unconditional love and mercy that I welcome you all to our new Parish. I am enthusiastic about the many possibilities we have together to spread the Good News as Disciples of Christ. I am looking forward to labor with you in the vineyard of the Lord.

As we continue our journey through the Operations Transition Phase of Renew My Church, a preparation for the final ministry phase of RMC, Building the New Reality, I want to ensure you that in collaboration with leaders at both St. Barbara and St. Therese and from the Archdiocese, we are making sure that our facilities, finances, and operations will run smoothly. There has been many good things happening as well as much work remaining to be done. I would like to offer you a quick update on Renew My Church and the life of our new parish.

Please join me in welcoming Fr. Lukas into our community as our Associate Pastor. We are also blessed to continue to have Fr. Andrzej, who has made a personal decision to transition from Associate Pastor to a resident priest. Our unified mass schedule is in place for our parish at both worship sites.

We continue to work on the following issues:

1. **Parish Name:** Discernment of a name began at the June Episcopal Council meeting. All names that were received in May were included for discernment. The list of suggested parish names is included as an insert in this weekend's bulletin. The list is also available in the church entrance areas, and the Parish offices for distribution. I was touched by the all very thoughtfully and prayerfully submitted names that were received. The Cardinal and the Episcopal Council need more time for discernment and ask for your continued prayers as they continue to work under the guidance of the Holy Spirit on a name for our faith community.
2. **Bulletin:** The Unification team will be working on a combined parish bulletin. While the unified bulletin is being designed, we will continue producing separate bulletins for each location under the unified parish.
3. **Website:** When we receive our new name, we will launch a new website. We will maintain the existing websites updating appropriate information for our unified community.
4. **Parish Office:** Our unified parish office will be located at the St. Barbara Rectory and the current St. Therese rectory office will be kept open. Current office hours remain the same at both locations. New office hours at each location will be announced later.



5. **Parish Staff:** We will begin to work on our parish staff model under the guidance of Renew My Church. All Church staff remains the same until further notice.
6. **Signage:** Parish signage will be updated in conjunction with us receiving our new parish name.
7. **Facilities:** You may recall from previous communications that facility improvements at St. Barbara were underway. After prayerful consideration we decided to place the improvements on hold to do a thorough assessment of all the buildings and conditions to determine how to most effectively utilize the resources we now have at our disposal.
8. Establishing a new Parish Pastoral Council and a new Finance Council will begin as soon as possible.
9. Religious Education and RCIA will begin to register students very soon at both worship sites.

In regard to our school; teachers will begin to check out their classrooms and we will do all the necessary work to get our classrooms ready for the new school year. New school signage will be put up during summer. I am looking forward to hearing suggestions on something to mark the occasion of the signage change.

Our Faith Formation Team has been working hard to evaluate and to plan for a unified formation program. The final decision will be announced as promised in late July or early August. I can assure you that we will have a wonderful program consisting of amazing spiritual and service opportunities for our children and families to grow in their love for Jesus and for one another. Our goal is to engage and form our children in the love of the Holy Spirit from womb to tomb.

Lastly, the Unification team will be meeting over the summer to work on the exciting new reality that makes up our unified parish. I want to express heartfelt appreciation to all those parishioners and friends for their sacrificial giving to enable us on our journey to create our new and exciting unified community of faith. The sacrifices are making our new parish stronger places from which to continue to carry out the mission of Christ in the world. Please continue to keep Renew My Church and the future of our Catholic faith community, in your prayers. Please do not hesitate to call me or write to me if you have any concerns or suggestions.

You are in my daily prayers and please keep me in yours.

### *"Listen and Follow" by Sister Caritas*

Sometimes we are asked to do something and the person making the request tells us how to do it. When we are teenagers or young, we want to do it the way we think is best. We try it our way and find out the suggestion of the other person was better.

Today's Gospel has Jesus sending His disciples out before Him. He gave them a specific role and power to complete the task. He also told them to follow His directives, where to go, and what attitude to have. He told them what to take, what to wear and what to say. Begin by saying to the town or persons, "Peace to this household." He also told them what to do if they are not received. He gave them directives about what to eat and where to stay. They followed His directives and the mission was successful. "...Do not rejoice because the spirits are subject to you, but rejoice because your names are written in heaven." In other words, have the right attitude in doing your ministry.

We have to remember, when we go to evangelize or to share Jesus, it does not matter what we have, what we wear, or where we stay. We do not even have to worry about what to say for the Spirit of God will use us. God's Spirit will give us the words to say. God's Spirit will lead us to where we should go and to whom we should speak. God's Spirit will prepare the person who is to listen. We need to be aware and to listen to the Spirit. WE will also be able to celebrate that our names "are written in heaven." Go out, follow the Spirit. Make a difference.
